REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
MAY 1, 2013

Ed Shamany called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Pledge Allegiance to the Flag

Present: Jon Dettery, Dennis Antonelli, Ed Shamany, Linda Croll, Attorney Karpowich

Motion was made to accept the minutes of previous meeting by Jon Dettery seconded by Dennis Antonelli. All in favor, motion carries.

Motion to dispense the reading of the minutes of previous meeting by Jon Dettery seconded by Dennis Antonelli. All in favor, motion carries.

Secretary Report/Correspondence & Police Report:
Report/Correspondence & Police Report was read by Linda Croll

Motion to accept the Secretary/Correspondence & Police Report by Jon Dettery seconded by Dennis Antonelli. All in favor, motion carries.

Dennis Antonelli read the Treasurers report. Treasurer's Report Attached

Motion by Jon Dettery, seconded by Ed Shamany to accept the Treasurers report. All in favor, motion carries.

Solicitors Report:

Amendments have been advertised for parking regulations. A conflict was discovered in our Zoning Ordinance. B-1/B-2 business will be changed to C-1/C-2 commercial. That will be addressed at the June 5th meeting.

There is also a dispute with North Union Township and East Union Township regarding a county boundary line. This resulted in a meeting with Sch. County Planning. It was a general consensus to use the Schuylkill Parcel locator in regards to the county line.

The Citizens Fire Company by Ordinance stated that all property should be delivered to the Township within 30 days. It fell on deaf ears. Letter must be sent giving them 5 days to return all property belonging to the Township.

Motion by Ed Shamany seconded by Dennis Antonelli to send letter to Citizens Fire Company requesting that the property is returned in 5 days of receipt of letter. All in favor, motion carries.

Discussion on Yunavage property. This started before Attorney Karpowich became Solicitor. Mr. Yunevage took it upon himself to deed a portion of Washington Street and put up barricades. Because of this the neighbors has difficulty accessing their property. A letter was sent to Mr. Yunavage's lawyer regarding a portion of the Township code. They missed the whole point we weren't talking about the entire road just the portion that was open. The Township only wants back up to the tree line.

Motion by Ed Shamany and seconded by Dennis Antonelli to start the legal process of taking back the road. All in favor, motion carries.

End of Solicitors report.

Motion by Jon Dettery and seconded by Dennis Antonelli to accept the Solicitors report. All in favor, motion carries.

Engineers Report :

A short report was given on the 2013 Road Project. Supervisors will review the estimated costs. Also the Oneida Storm Project and speaking with PennDOT to get assistance with the Project as it is a state road. The Jake Brake issued was discussed.

Motion was made Dennis Antonelli, seconded by Jon Dettery to have ARRO continue working in regards to the Jake Brake issue . All in favor, motion Carries.

Supervisor Antonelli then stated that the Oneida Storm Project had to be done this year.

Motion was made by Jon Dettery and seconded by Dennis Antonelli to accept the Engineers report. All in favor, motion carries.

Old Business: None

New Business:

Request from Valley Forge Trail Riders for consent from the Supervisors to cross certain state roadways in the Township during the Moonshine Enduro held Sunday, Sept. 15, 2013.

Motion was made by Dennis Antonelli, seconded by Jon Dettery to give consent to the Valley Forge Trail Riders. All in favor, motion carries.

Resolution #2 or 2013 (Act 537 Plan Update Revision – Special Study Corrective Action Plan) which provides for the correction of infiltration and inflow into the existing wastewater collection and conveyance system that service the Villages of Sheppton & Oneida.

Motion by Dennis Antonelli, seconded by Jon Dettery to accept Resolution #2 of 2013. All in favor, motion carries.

Public Comments:

Adele Zaremba asked why we are doing road work for PennDOT. Supervisor Antonelli stated

that it is not road work, it's actually pipe work. PennDOT claims they didn't put in any pipes entirely up the road, they only do across the road. The roads are caving in. We tried to get PennDOT to do it to no avail. We will try to set up a meeting with PennDOT and State Representative and Senator.

Adele Zaremba then asked that someone explain Resolution #2 of 2013. She was told it was a corrective action plan which provides for the correction and inflow in the existing wastewater collection and conveyance system. It was an order made by the DEP.

Attorney Karpowich requested that a representative from the EUT Sewer Authority attend the EUT Supervisors meeting every month and give a Sewer Report.

Secretary Linda Croll will send them a letter.

Dennis Conti said he needs water. He was told that if his problems were as serious as he was saying it should be looked into. He was told to bring in test report that was done on his water and we would be more than happy to help him. Mr. Conti thinks the solution to his problem is to shut the farms down. He also wants an Ordinance to stop people from Shenandoah from moving into town. Mr. Conti then showed Exhibit A, a new penny with holes.

Charlie DeCosmo then stated there was a safety hazard with property on Pine St. Officer Harris will be in touch with the owner in regards to this as it needs to be fenced off.
