REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING
September 4, 2013

Ed Shamany called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M.

Correspondence/Police Report:

Treasurers Report:

Solicitors Report:

Bids were prepared for the Bulk Waste Collection. At this time they were opened and read by Dennis Antonelli. Kreitzer Sanitation Bid: 24 month period \$82,800.00; Thomas Enterprises Bid: 24 month period \$72,000.00.

Motion was made by Ed Shamany to table bids, seconded by Dennis Antonelli. All in favor, motion carries.

Attorney Karpowich then said he advertised to amend the SALDO Ordinance. That will be done at the October meeting.

Then Dennis spoke regarding the meeting the Supervisors had with the Grant Writer. He also stated about making the Shepton Mine Disaster a Historical Site. We will have to get in touch with whoever owes the property. Dennis spoke with a few people who said they would help

with the project. There were people at the meeting who are very interested with this project. They had a petition with them regarding this. A committee was formed at this time.

Solicitor Karpowich stated that we are applying for a \$40,000 recreation grant.

Donna Gulash gave the sewer report and said that someone would be going around inspecting homes for illegal discharge

Old Business:

Repository Sale of Parcel #09-22-0007.000 and Parcel #09-21-0159.000.

Valley Forge Trail Riders request for consent to use certain township roads.

Motion by Ed Shamany, seconded by Dennis Antonelli to deny consent by advice from Officer Tony Harris & Solicitor Karpowich. All in favor, motion carries.

New Business:

A Resolution of the Governing Board of EUT authorizing, empowered and directing the proper Officers of the Governing Board to appoint a liaison between it and Berkheimer, the duly appointed collector of Earned Income Tax for the Tax Collection District. Attorney Karpowich then went on to explain exactly what that means.

Motion by Ed Shamany, seconded by Dennis Antonelli to accept the Resolution. All in favor, motion carries.

There was a brief discussion regarding the Brandonville Fire Company and where the money

went for a truck that was sold.

Public Comments:

Jill Careyva how much Spring Clean Up cost last year. She was told approx. \$15,000.00.

Dennis Antonelli stated that we would probably designate different areas in the township to be picked up each quarter.

We're also going to look into electronic recycling. Adele Zaremba then said they were having one in Ringtown this month and she would get the info to the Secretary.
