JOHN BIROS SAID ONCE IT IS PICKED UP THEY ARE NOT GOING BACK, WE ARE LOOKING AT \$35-\$40K FOR SPRING CLEANUP AND WE HAVE TO GET CONTROL OF THIS. ALL WE'RE TAKING IS WHAT IS ON THE LIST AND WHATEVER IS LISTED IS ALL WE WILL PICK UP. WHATEVER IS NOT PICKED UP, THE HOME OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE TO REMOVE. STEVE BUSHINKSI SAYS MORE GARBAGE IS PUT ON HIS PILE AFTER HE PUTS HIS THINGS OUT, THE WORKERS WILL PICK UP WHAT IS ON HIS PILE ACCORDING TO OUR LIST ON HIS PICKUP DAY.

MOTION TO GRANT FINAL CONDITIONAL SUBDIVISION APPROVAL FOR MERICLE LOTS 57 & 57 IN THE HUMBOLT INDUSTRIAL PARK BASED ON SATISFYING THE CONDITIONS IN THE ARRO REVIEW LETTER DATED MARCH 21, 2019 WAS MADE BY JOHN BIROS, SECONDED BY JON DETTERY. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

MOTION FOR WAIVERS FROM SEC. 403 (PRELIMINARY, FINAL PLAN APPROVAL), A FINANCIAL SECURITY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR MERICLE LOT 57B WAS MADE BY JOHN BIROS, SECONDED BY JON DETTERY. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

MOTION TO GRANT FINAL CONDITIONAL LAND DEVELOPMENT APPROVAL FOR MERICLE LOT 57B IN HUMBOLT INDUSTRIAL PARK BASED ON SATISFYING THE CONDITIONS IN THE ARRO REVIEW LETTER DATED MARCH 26, 2019 INCLUDING THE FOLLOWING: PROVIDE A DEED OF EASEMENT FOR ACCESS FROM LOT 60, PROVIDE A LETTER OF CREDIT FOR IMPROVEMENTS AND OBTAIN A NPDES PERMIT WAS APPROVED JOHN BIROS, SECONDED BY JON DETTERY. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

MOTION TO GRANT VALLEY FORGE TRAIL RIDERS REQUEST FOR CONSENT LETTER FOR YEARLY ENDURO RIDE (COPY OF INSURANCE PROVIDED AND PENNDOT PERMIT) WILL BE PROVIDED WHEN RECEIVED WAS MADE BY JOHN BIROS, SECONDED BY JON DETTERY. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

MOTION TO RENEW CONTRACT WITH TRI COUNTY BUSINESS MONTHLY SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR COPIER AT \$20.00 PER MONTH WAS MADE BY JOHN BIROS, SECONDED BY JON DETTERY. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: TOM HOUSER QUESTIONED THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PART OF THE MEETING-PROCEDURES ARE FOR SUPERVISORS TO ASK IF ANY COMMENTS BEFORE A MOTION IS MADE. MIKE GAIZICK ASKED FOR A WAIVER OF FEE OF \$485.00 TO DO EXCAVATION FOR ROAD OPENING TO REPAIR A SEWER MAIN ON SCHOOL HOUSE ROAD FOR THE SEWER AUTHORITY-TOM HOUSER ASKED WHEN IT WILL BE DONE, UNKNOWN AT THIS TIME. JOHN BIROS SAID A PROCEDURE MUST BE DONE BY PENNDOT SPECIFICATIONS AND THE \$485.00 IS JUST A FEE TO DO THE WORK AND IT IS 2 DIFFERENT ENTITIES AND THE SEWER AUTHORITY SHOULD PAY THE FEE. MIKE SAID IT COULD CAUSE HIGHER SEWER FEES. BILL MCMULLEN SAID IF THE ROAD IS DAMAGED THE TOWNSHIP MUST PAY FOR REPAIRS. PAM HARTZ SPOKE ABOUT THE FERAL CAT SITUATION THAT SHE HAS BROUGHT UP AT PREVIOUS MEETINGS AND NOTHING IS BEING DONE. OFFICER WILLIAMS IS SUPPOSE TO TAKE CARE OF IT AND NOONE IS BEING CITED. ACCORDING TO THE ORDINANCE, PEOPLE SHOULD BE CITED PER ANIMAL, PER DAY AND NOTHING IS HAPPENING. THEY ARE HAVING PROBLEMS THROUGHOUT THE TOWNSHIP WITH FERAL CATS. SHE STILL GETS PHONE CALLS AND SHE IS NO LONGER ANIMAL CONTROL. MATT REACHED OUT TO THE SPCA AND THEY DON'T HAVE THE RESOURCES. WE NEED SOMEONE TO TAKE CARE OF THIS. SUPERVISOR BIROS SAID WE'RE GOING TO HAVE TO WORK ON GETTING THIS TAKEN CARE OF. TOM HOUSER SUGGESTED A MAN IN RINGTOWN TRAPS ANIMALS AND HE MIGHT BE ABLE TO HELP. STEVE BUSHINSKI SAID LAST YEAR THE SUPERVISORS AGREED TO PAY LEGAL FEES FOR THE AUDITORS FOR THE INVESTIGATION OF THE FORMER TREASURER AND HAS HE SUBMITTED ANY BILLS YET AND WERE THEY APPROVED. ATTY BARANKO SAID A FEE WAS SET THAT WOULD NOT EXCEED THE TOWNSHIP SOLICITORS FEE AT \$95.00/HR. STEVE BUSHINSKI SENT A LETTER TO EACH SUPERVISOR AND ASKED FOR A CHANGE INTO THE TREASURER'S REPORT, HE WANTS COPIES FOR THE PUBLIC AVAILABLE AT THE MONTHLY MEETINGS ALSO WITH THE PROBLEMS WITH THE PREVIOUS TREASURER-ALL SALARIES SHOULD BE REPORTED SO PEOPLE KNOW. MISTAKES WERE MADE, IT WAS A MAJOR BLACK EYE FOR THE TOWNSHIP WITH THE PREVIOUS TREASURER. THERESA GAIZICK SPOKE ABOUT

REMIND.COM A NOTIFICATION SYSTEM FOR TRAFFIC UPDATES AND MEETING UPDATES. IT IS A FREE SYSTEM BUT NEEDS AN ADMINISTRATOR.
