THERESA GAIZICK SPOKE ON IDEAS FOR THE PROPERTY AT 939 AND 941 CENTER ST. SHE MET WITH REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE HAZLETON ARE PUBLIC LIBRARY AND HAD SOME IDEAS WE COULD USE FOR A COMMUNITY CENTER BUT ARE NOT ABLE TO HAVE A LIBRARY BECAUSE OF THE NUREMBERG LIBRARY BEING 5 MILES AWAY FROM US. THERE IS GRANT MONEY OUT THERE AND SHE HAS A CONTACT THAT WILL HELP HER WITH THIS. SHE WILL BE LOOKING INTO WHAT WE CAN DO.

JOBS WILL BE PUT OUT ON BIDS AND WE WILL DECIDE WHICH WILL BE DONE.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: MARIO CURELLI-ASKED IF THE ATTORNEY WILL REACH OUT TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL ABOUT THE BRANDONVILLE FIRE COMPANY, PEOPLE ARE BREAKING INTO THE BUILDING AND IT IS FALLING APART. ATTORNEY WILL CONTACT THE AG ALSO COPY JUDGE BALDWIN ON THE MATTER. SANDY MUMICH-REQUEST TO LOOK AT STORM RUN OFF BY THEIR HOUSE ON SCHOOLHOUSE ROAD- NOTHING HAS BEEN DONE SINCE THEIR REQUEST IN OCTOBER, 2016. THEY HAVE BEEN PROMISED THINGS AND NOTHING HAS BEEN DONE. THE AREA IS NOTHING BUT SWAMP. HER HUSBAND WANTS THE OLD SEWER LINES SHUT DOWN. JOHN BIROS SAID THE TOWNSHIP IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE REPAIR OF THE OLD LINES BECAUSE THE LINES WERE NEVER CONDEMMED. A CAMERA WAS USED TO FIND THE PROBLEM AND THE DRAIN WAS BLOCK AND THE TOWNSHIP CLEANED IT OUT. DEP WILL BE CONTACTED ABOUT THE MATTER. DAVE LAPINSKY-WHEN IS THE BURN ORDINANCE GOING INTO EFFECT-IT IS BEING WORKED ON. BILL GEORGE-LEASE ARE BLOCKING DRAIN ON HEMLOCK DRIVE AND WANTS IT TAKEN CARE OF. TOM HOUSER-ASKED ABOUT MONEY PAID FOR SURCHARGE TO ATTY KARPOVICH, OUR CPA MUST REVIEW AND CERTIFY THE AUDITORS REPORT. JILL CAREYVA-WANTED TO COMMEND THE ROAD CREW ON A JOB WELL DONE, SHE CALLED ABOUT TREES BEING DOWN ON THE ROADS AND THE WORKERS WENT RIGHT DOWN AND CLEANED IT UP. EDWINA MATUSZKIEWICZ-WANTED TO KNOW WHAT THE RECCOMENDATIONS ARE ON THE BURN ORDINANCE.
