NEW BUSINESS:

939-941 CENTER ST PROPERTY USE. IF ANYONE HAS ANY SUGGESTIONS IT WILL BE DISCUSSED AT NEXT MEETING.

MOTION TO TRANSFER \$21,390.49 FROM THE LST FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND WAS MADE BY JON DETTERY, SECONDED BY DENNIS ANTONELLI. ALL IN FAVOR, MOTION CARRIES.

DISCUSSION ON THE DENNISON PROPERTY IN BRANDONVILLE-IT IS IN DEP'S HANDS. JONATHAN BIROS MET WITH THEM 2 TIMES AND THEY WERE CHECKING FOR UNDERGROUND GAS TANKS BUT HASN'T HAD ANY RESPONSE FROM THEM. DENNIS ANTONELLI QUESTIONED IF THE TOWNSHIP CAN CLEAN IT

UP. ATTY BARNANKO SAID WE COULD PUT A MUNICIPAL LIEN AGAINST THE PROPERTY AND TRY TO RECOUP OUR EXPENSES. HE WILL ALSO CONTACT DEP AGAIN.

DISCUSSION ON RECYCLING-WE WILL START BEING CHARGED PER TON JUNE 1, 2019 AND WE MUST LOOK FOR OTHER OPTIONS. DENNIS ANTONELLI THINKS WE SHOULD LOOK AT A COMPACTOR AND THINGS WILL BE SORTED. BOB GABARDI SAID THE BINS BELONG TO COUNTY AND THEY SHOULD BE PICKING IT UP. THE SECRETARY WILL CALL THE COURTHOUSE TO LOOK INTO OTHER OPTIONS.

PUBLIC DISCUSSION-JOHN MASKORNICH QUESTIONED IF THE TOWNSHIP KNEW OF A HOUSING DEVELOPMENT ON INDUSTRIAL ROAD. NO PERMITS HAVE BEEN ISSUED FOR BUILDING. HIS CONCERN IS ABOUT DRAINAGE AND HIS WELL WATER. HE WANTS TO MAKE SURE EVERYTHING IS DONE LEGALLY. MARK BERNHAUSER IS THE CURRENT OWNER OF THE PROPERTY AND SPOKE OF HIS PLANS. ATTY BARANKO QUESTIONED IF THEY ARE PUTTING IN ROADS AND HE IS NOT AT THE PRESENT TIME. WITH ALL THE LITTERING AND TRESPASSING HE IS CLEANING UP THE PROPERTY AND WILL BE BUILDING A HOME ON 40 ACRES. JONATHAN BIROS STATED MR BERNHAUSER IS IN COMPLIANCE UP TO DATE. JOHN MASKORNICH SAID THE OLD OWNER NEVER DID ANYTHING WITH THE PROPERTY BECAUSE IT DIDN'T PERK AND NOW IT DOES. WHY DOESN'T THE TOWNSHIP HAVE RECORDS OF THE PERKS TESTS PERFORMED AND THEY ARE IN POSSESSION OF BILL BRIOR. THE ORIGINAL PERK TESTS WERE DONE FOR 170 HOMES ON THE PROPERTY IN 2006 SO IT DIDN'T PASS. ONLY 1 HOME IS BEING BUILT ON THE PROPERTY. THE ZONING OFFICER WILL KEEP UP TO DATE ON IT.
