


Low Taxes - Large Accomplishments


- 17th Consecutive Year of No Tax Increase!
- Out of 68 municipalities in Schuylkill County, we are the 5th lowest in taxes.
- Compare East Union (2.45 Mills) to our neighbors:
 - North Union Township – 4.80 Mills (Double!!)
 - Union Township – 7.25 Mills (Triple!!!)
 - Mahanoy Township – 12.09 Mills (Quintuple!!!!)



2026 Budget



- Total budgeted expenses of \$647,320 in 2026.
- Small Budget – Big Achievements



- If you pay \$1,000 in county/municipal taxes, \$900 goes to Schuylkill County, \$100 goes to EUT.
- Efficiency means getting the MOST done with the LEAST.






